



Weddings and Events at Budle Hall

Budle Hall is a graceful, gently aged Georgian house, the perfect setting for a romantic wedding.

Close to Budle Bay and Bamburgh, surrounded by private grounds and gardens, there is endless scope for any event you might dream of.

The accommodation in the house consists of three double ensuite rooms, a bridal suite of four rooms and a twin room with private bath/shower room. Usually, the bridal party stay in the house, taking the rooms for at least two nights, thus ensuring the exclusive use of the house and gardens which gives a feeling of being married from home rather than a hotel.

Dinner can be provided for the house party and guests on the night before the wedding if desired, and/or a lunch party the day after.

We don't lay down set formulas or rigid structures, but work with you to create something unique. We can provide a marquee for larger numbers although the house and gardens can cope with smaller parties.

We work with several marquee providers (see links) who have set up here in the past, from tepees to very large formal affairs. The marquee becomes part of the house by connecting directly to the French windows in the dining room which then opens up all the formal rooms of Budle Hall the drawing room, dining room, two halls and the library along with all the facilities of the house for the event. This works very well for large parties with music and dancing and for those who wish to escape can use the rooms in the house without leaving the party.

By far the best caterers we work with are Matthew and Zoe Rawlings who provide excellent 'real' not 'catering food, properly cooked and sourced locally.

We have a full drinks licence and will provide wine and champagne lists for the event, reception drinks and a pay bar. You choose what we serve from real ale to Pimms or anything else you might like.

Our venue/management fee for the event covers management of all arrangements, events licence, public liability insurance, setting up of tables, extra house staff, bar staff, flowers, wedding planning, decoration of the house and generally running around fixing all those last minute things from making buttonholes when the florist forgot to deliver them, and providing wedding ribbons for the bridal car when the ones provided were too short... oh and giving the father of the bride a stiff drink before setting off for the ceremony!

We can recommend local people for all those extra things such as hairdressers and manicurists who will come to the house, wedding cars, musicians and cake makers.

We can offer inhouse services for floristry, table and marquee decoration, table linen, wedding invitations and orders of service at very competitive prices.

In the past, we have had bagpipers, Northumbrian pipers, ceilidh bands, hog roasts, oyster bar, jugglers and fireworks.

Every event is unique and it is up to you to let your imagination run wild and up to us to turn it into reality!
